GM/SM Reductions

Thank you for your letter of the 26 May 2011 regarding the above matter.

For the sake of convenience I will address the issues in the same sequence set out in your letter.

- 1. I understand that the occurrence of major incidents and the impact that this might have with respect to the proposals to reduce the number of GM/SM is dealt with in the risk assessment that supports this proposal. I can also advise you that the risk assessment that was originally sent to you when consultation was initiated has now been updated following dialogue with FOA. Could I therefore request that you review this document as the new content may impact on the various questions you have raised in your letter pertaining to the risk assessment? I have therefore enclosed a copy of the revised risk assessment for your consideration.
- 2. You the FBU state that was not involved in previous consultations/negotiations regarding the historical reduction in GM/SM numbers to their current levels. As I was not involved in this process I can not offer any insight as to what did or did not occur and I do not propose to conduct an autopsy of the alleged failings of previous consultations. I would prefer to focus on the current proposal to reduce to GM/SM to a level of 8 and 16 respectively, which falls within the terms of reference of this consultation exercise and I would respectfully suggest that this should also be the focus for the FBU if both parties are to make best use of the time available.

- 3. I am not sure exactly what you are asking of me in this paragraph but my assumption is that you are making a request for the documentation relating to consultation with FOA. If you could clarify your position in this respect I might be in a better position to offer assistance and explanation.
- 4. Your point in this regard seems to be a semantic one and it is not my intention to lose focus with regard to the key issues that are presently the subject of consultation. There are currently a number of options on the table for consideration, irrespective of how they are characterized, and I would suggest that our deliberations should address the issues that arise out of these options, not a debate on how they might be described.
- 5. It is a matter of choice for individuals regarding which of the 2 systems they prefer. No individual is being denied the option to work more covers if they wish as they can elect to work within the more flexible duty system. Although I note that the thrust of the FOA position is that their members do not wish to provide additional covers.
- 6. My view is that the proposal you refer to in this paragraph does not require employees to opt out of the Working Time Regulations, although in this respect I would defer to the greater competence of the Clerk to whom I will refer the matter for a definitive answer
- 7. I have enclosed a copy the mobilizing data for GM/SM which I believe will provide the FBU with the detail sought.
- 8. With regard to your comment regarding the risks assessment could I refer you to the comment I made in paragraph 1 of this letter
- 9. With regard to the matters you raise in paragraph 9 and 10 I can confirm that the staffing model upon which the Service proposal is founded provides sufficient resilience to meet the leave needs of the Service.
- 10. See response to paragraph 9 above.
- 11. Thank you for your comments in paragraph 11 which I duly note and with regard to which I will take the appropriate action.
- 12. I have enclosed a copy of CFO/219/05 as requested.
- 13. You raise a number of issues in relation to the EIA in paragraphs 13 through to 16 and I will therefore arrange a meeting with Jayne Monkhouse, as a matter of priority, to hopefully assuage your concerns.
