2009/10 Annual efficiency statement - backward look for fire & resilience services

The Authority has achieved all bar one of the efficiency savings outlined in its 2009/10 Forward AES. The self-rostering efficiency, £360,000, is now being implemented in 2010/11 as the consultation exercise with the relevant stakeholders did not conclude until towards the end of 2009/10.

An additional permanent saving of £400,000 on inflation and procurement provisions was identified in the year and utilised to increase the general reserve in 2009/10 and contribute to reducing future years savings. This has been included in the procurement section of the AES.
