At the start of the meeting, the Chair agreed to consider Agenda Item 3 – Verbal update and presentation concerning High Rise Fires at the start of the Agenda.

3. High Rise Fires

(Verbal Presentation)

Following a recent incident in Southampton where two firefighters lost their lives, Members were provided with a verbal update and PowerPoint Presentation by Station Manager Steve Pratt, concerning Merseyside Fire & Rescue Services' Action Plan for High Rise buildings, to put their minds at rest with regards to procedures currently in place for dealing with such incidents

Following this, Members were provided with a further presentation by Group Manager Rob Pritchard, providing an overview of the recent High Rise Research Project conducted by MFRS in conjunction with the Merseyside Group of the IFE, which highlighted the main research findings.

Members noted the content of both presentations and thanked the Officers for the re-assurance.

1. Preliminary Matters

- (a) Councillor Lesley Rennie declared a Personal Interest in relation to Agenda Item 4 Disposal Of Obsolete Fire Appliances & Equipment (Humanitarian Aid), due to being a member of the Birkenhead Rotary Club.

2. <u>Minutes of Previous Meeting</u>
