#### 1. <u>Preliminary Matters</u>

Members considered Report CFO/012/09 of the Chief Fire Officer concerning the Provision of Firefighting Helmets and approved the purchase of the new "Gallet" Firefighting helmet to be rolled out to all operational personnel within Merseyside Fire & Rescue Service.

## 5. IDEAS Scheme

Members considered and noted Report CFO/014/09 of the Deputy Chief Fire Officer concerning the IDEAS (Initiatives Delivering Excellence and Safety) Scheme and its progress to date.

Members resolved that nominations be sought for an Elected Member to sit on the IDEAS Committee.

#### 6. <u>IRMP Action Point 7.2.2 - Attendance Standards for Road Traffic</u> <u>Collisions</u> (CFO/015/09)

Members considered Report CFO/015/09 of the Chief Fire Officer concerning IRMP Action Point 7.2.2 – Attendance Standards for Road Traffic Collisions.

## Resolved that:

(a) to approve a new Service Attendance Standard where it is reported that persons are trapped as a result of a road traffic collision, Merseyside Fire and Rescue Service will attend the incident within 8 minutes of the notification and will aim to achieve this standard on 90% of occasions.

- (b) to note the introduction of Casualty Comfort packs on all frontline appliances.
- (c) that Members are to be provided with a breakdown of the costs involved in disposable Casualty Comfort packs as opposed to reusable ones.
- (d) to include RTC attendance in future indicator sets.
- (e) that research is to be undertaken into why certain types of incident are more prevalent in some areas eg. RTC's in Wirral.

# 7. Value for Money Strategy

#### (CFO/016/09)

Members considered Report CFO/016/09 of the Chief Fire Officer concerning the Authority's approach to securing Value for Money.

#### Resolved that:

- (a) the Value for Money Strategy is to be approved.
- (b) more consideration is to be given to sustainability issues when the Value for Money strategy is reviewed.
- (c) 'Health & Safety and Environmental Implications' sections are to be added to all Committee report templates.

#### 8. <u>Public Consultation of the Feasibility of a Volunteer Station within the</u> <u>Rainford Area.</u> (CFO/018/09)

Members considered Report CFO/018/09 of the Deputy Chief Fire Officer concerning recommendations relating to a Volunteer Fire Station in the Rainford Area.

#### Resolved that:

- (a) Members noted the recommendations contained in the Report and the preference expressed by the local community through the consultation process. In view of the lack of finance available in the context that the Authority has resources in place to meet its risks in this area under its Integrated Risk Management Plan, the Authority agreed to take no further action to progress this issue, however, the Chief Fire Officer is requested to meet with communities to thank them for their input and to explain the decision.
- (b) the issue be raised with the Fire Minister on his forthcoming visit to Merseyside on 25<sup>th</sup> February 2009.

# 9. <u>4 Year Data Analysis of Incidents</u> (CFO/017/09)

Members considered Report CFO/017/09 of the Deputy Chief Fire Officer concerning the Fire Data Analysis for the four years until 31<sup>st</sup> March 2008.

## Resolved that:

- (a) Reports be brought back to the Authority covering the following areas:
  - The 'Worst Offenders' for false alarm calls to the Service.
  - Void properties both residential and commercial and the work we are doing with partnership agencies to minimise the risk they pose.
- (b) Members be provided with updated statistics on:
  - Firefighter injuries, particularly in relation to injuries sustained at incidents.
  - Violence at Work following the installation of CCTV on all front line appliances.
- (c) this data is to be made available to Liverpool District Management Teams.
- (d) modelling be carried out and brought back to Members regarding the future deployment of second pumps across the twenty-six stations.
- (e) the next incident analysis is to include a breakdown of Special Service and Marine Rescue calls.
