

DISTRICT MANAGER'S IRMP CONSULTATION 2009

The MF&RS managers responsible for the Five Districts arranged and delivered wide ranging consultation to various stakeholder groups in their areas on IRMP2 Action Plan 3.

The Public were also canvassed for their views at Huyton, Prescot and Kirby Town Centres and provided feedback on the services MF&RS are providing to their local communities.

St Helens District:

IRMP presentations were delivered to St Helen full Council, the CDRP Executive, Communities and Neighbourhood Partnerships Strategic Board, Renew Parr Management Board, Road Safety Joint Agency Group and Town Centre and Finger Post Management Group.

Wirral District:

Wirral District wrote to partners, politicians, public bodies and area forums informing them of the IRMP publication and encouraging them to become involved in the consultation.

Station and Locality Managers held evening meetings at Community Fire Stations across the region for the public to attend and comment on the IRMP.

Liverpool District:

The IRMP was presented to Liverpool Corporate Services Select Committee and the Liverpool Management team attended 14 Your Community Matters events to further involve people in the IRMP.

The average turn out at the community events was 20 and covered issues such as young and elderly, environment, crime and community safety, business and commerce.

Sefton District:

Sefton presented the IRMP to various strategic groups including Sefton Borough Partnership (a partnership of public, business, voluntary and community sectors), Sefton Council Communities Committee, Sefton Council Cabinet and Crosby Area Committee.
