Purpose of Report

1. To request that Members approve the change in membership of the Audit Committee.

Recommendation

Introduction and Background

- 3. At the Authority's AGM on 13th June 2019, Members agreed the Authority's Committee Structure for the 2019/20 Municipal Year, which included an Audit Committee, consisting of 5 voting Members, plus the Independent Person, in a non-voting capacity.
- 4. Under the provisions of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989, the Authority is required to allocate seats on its Committees according to its political balance. For the Municipal Year 2019/20, this translates to the appointment of four Labour Members; and one Opposition Member (either Liberal Democrat or Conservative) on to the Audit Committee.
