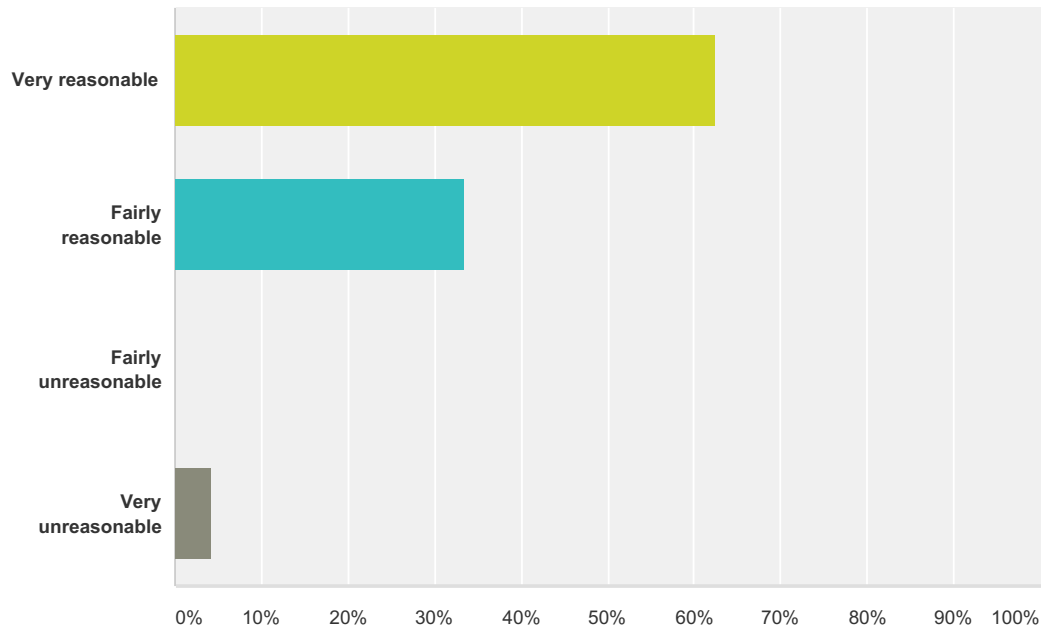

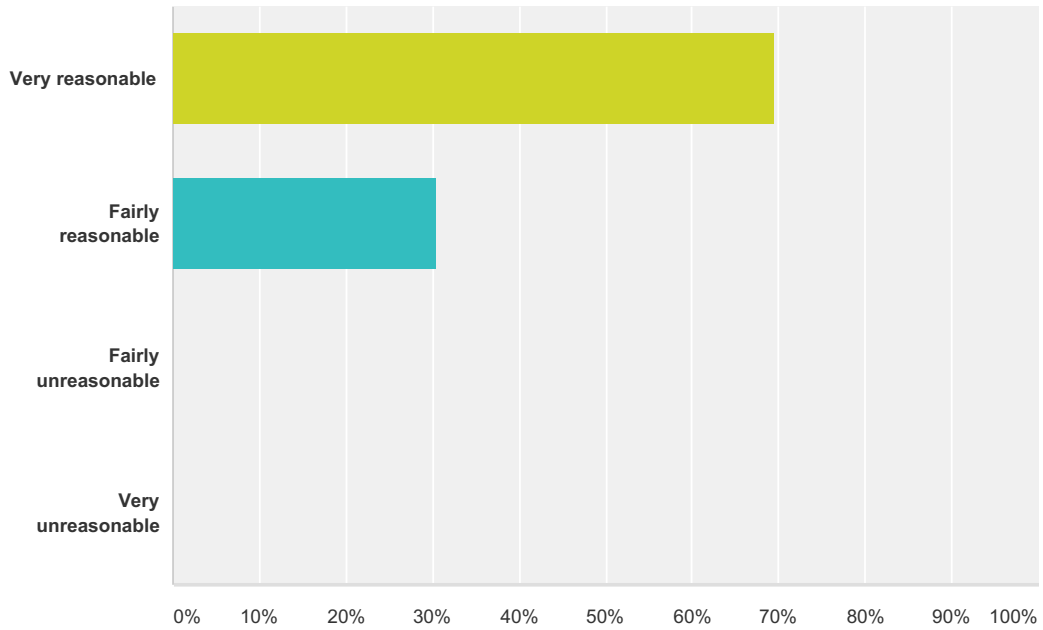

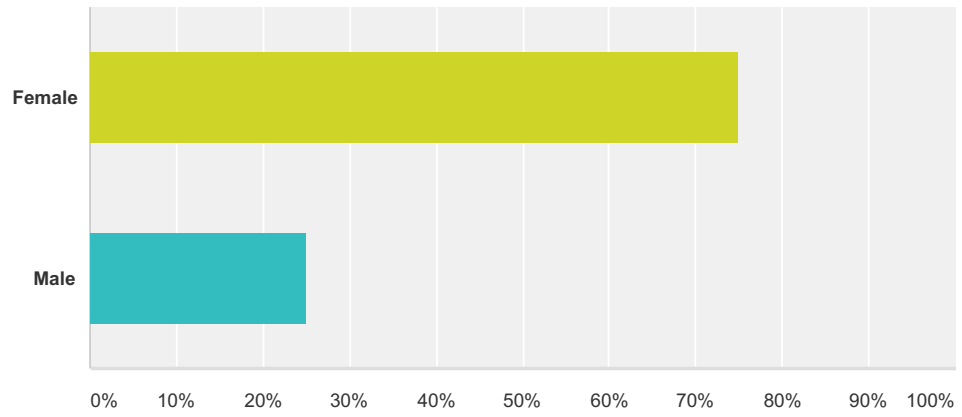

### Q8 Gender:

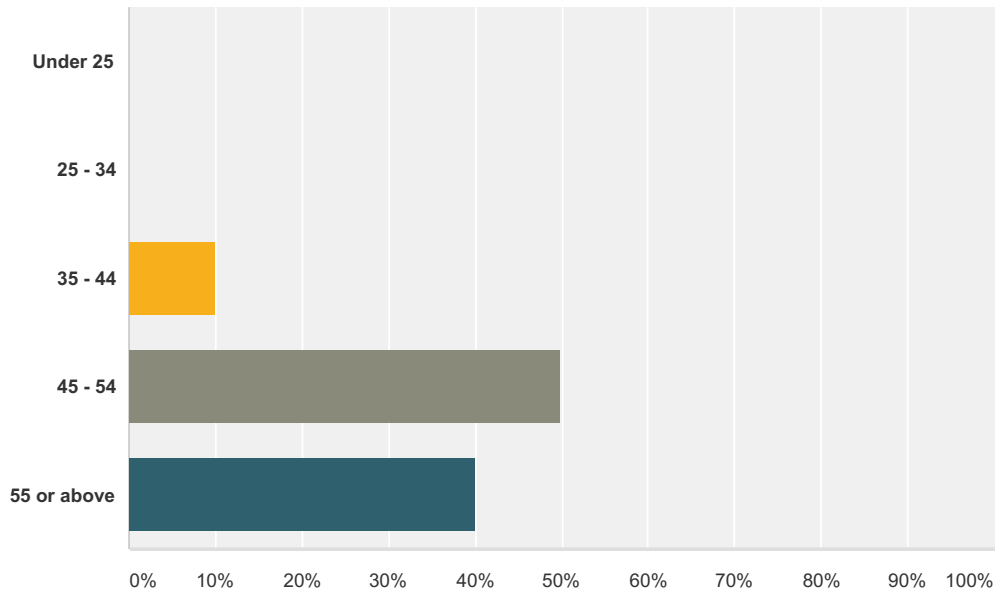

### Q9 Which age group do you belong to?

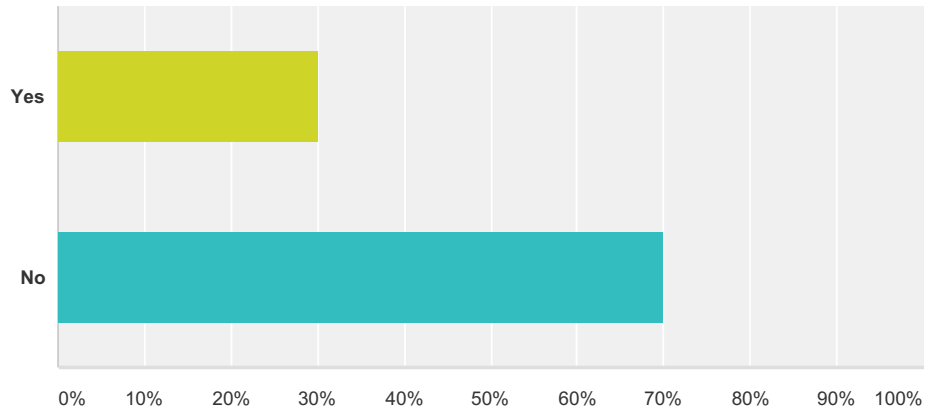

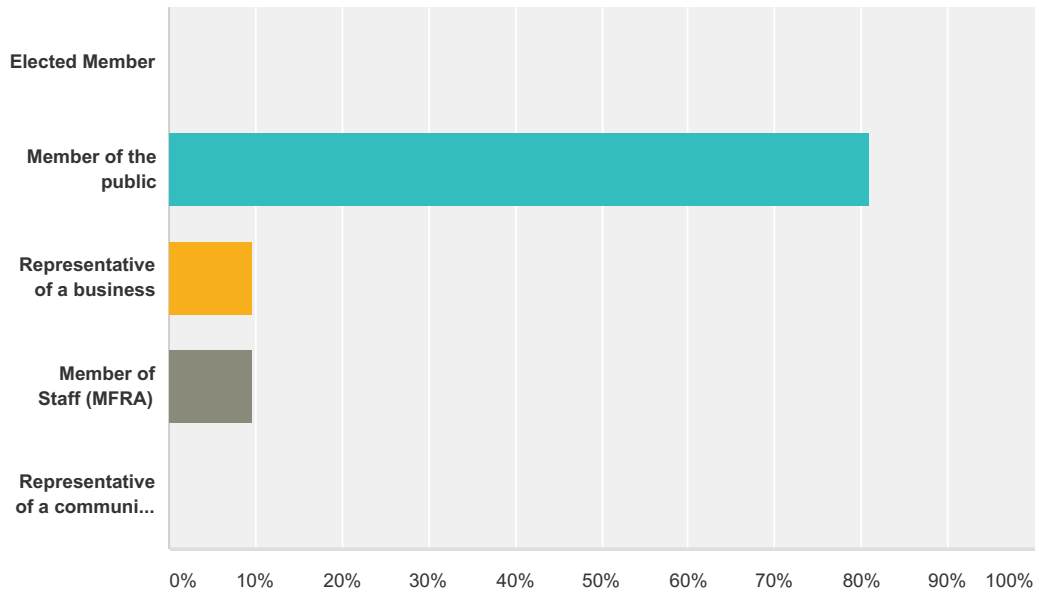
